## **Welcome to Quizzability's The Sustainable Development Goals Game !**

- This game is a basic approach to the SDGs, where students get to learn about each SDG. It is meant to be played in class, where students will have the opportunity to engage with the United Nations' Sustainable Development goals.
- If it is the first-time students are dealing with the SDGs, you can use the SDG cards as clues for the game.
- There are two possible ways to play the game:

# Rules

## Game type #1 rules:

1. Divide the class into teams of 2-4 players.
2. Each team takes turns answering the questions.
3. If a team answers a question correctly, they get a point (or the corresponding SDG card. See below).
4. The team with the most points at the end of the game wins.
5. To make the game more challenging, you can add a timer and give teams a certain amount of time to answer each question.

# Rules

## Game type #2 rules:

1. Divide the class into teams of 2-4 players.
2. Read all the questions out loud.
3. Allow a certain amount of time for the groups to write down their answers.
4. After all questions have been read, the teacher reveals the correct answers.
5. When a team answers a question correctly, they get a point (or the corresponding SDG card. See below).
6. Tally up each group's score.
7. The group with the most correct answers wins.
